1 BASILICA OF S. PIETRO IN CIEL D'ORO

The altar hosts the silver urn containing St Augustine's relics; in the presbytery, St Augustine's sarcophagus, a Gothic sculptural masterpiece dated to the second St Augustine's sarcophagus, a Gothic sculptural masterpiece dated to the second half of the 14th century; on the counter-façade, 'St Augustine before the Assumption'; on the domed vault ceiling, a tempera painting by Bernardi and Loverini (1900), showing St Augustine and St Monica; in the crypt: in the middle, a pseudo- sarcophagus with the carved image of St Augustine (16th century); in between stairs, 'St Augustine sleeping', sculpted by Pinuccio Sciola (20th century); in the north nave, a 20th century-painting by Maria Angelini showing St Augustine and St Monica; in the sacristy: on the back wall, a painting by Giovan Battista Tassinari showing the apparition of St Jerome to St Augustine (1599); on the vault, amongst the grotesques, a medallion showing St Augustine meditating (second half of 16th century). CATHEDRAL

The south side of the transept initially comprised a Neoclassical chapel that hosted St Augustine's sarcophagus. The artwork was moved from the Church of St Pietro in Ciel d'Oro when its order was suppressed, and the building closed (1832); St Augustine's relics are on the altar table in the Chapel of the Sacred Heart. CASTIGLIONI- BRUGNATELLI COLLEGE
The college was established under the protection of St Augustine. The complex comprises a beautiful chapel dedicated to the saint (second half of the 15 century). Via S. Martino, 20 - open upon request

CHURCH OF S. MARIA DELLE GRAZIE
In the presbytery, a painting by Everardus Van Der Doort, 'The passing of St
Augustine' (1616). Viale Partigiani, 103 - opening times 7.00am-6.00pm

CHURCH OF S. MARIA DEL CARMINE

In the Chapel of the Immaculate Conception, south nave: a polyptych attributed In the Chapel of the Immaculate Conception, south nave: a polyptych attributed to Bernardino Lanzani, showing St Ambrose and St Augustine (beginning of the 17th century); in the third chapel, north nave (temporary location), a painting by Pietro Maggi, showing St Augustine and Maria Maddalena de' Pazzi (beginning of the 17th century); In the sacristy, a painting with Baby Jesus with a shell explaining to St Augustine the mystery of the Holy Trinity (17th century). AULA MAGNA OF THE UNIVERSITY OF PAVIA
St Augustine is the patron saint of the University of Pavia. On the left-hand side after
the entrance, a statue of St Augustine dated to the 15 century. Piazza Leonardo da Vinci, 12 - open during special events

BROLETTO - AULA MAGNA - IUSS PAVIA

Close to the Sala del Camino (Aula Magna of IUSS - Scuola Universitaria Superiore of Pavia), a fresco showing St Augustine protecting some abbots under his mantle (1507). Piazza della Vittoria - open during special events PAVIA CITY OF ST AUGUSTINE

CHURCH OF S. SALVATORE

The lunettes in the apse show the series of the Four Doctors of the Church (beginning of the 16"century). Via Riviera, 20 - opening times 7.30am-12.30pm | 4.00-6.30pm

GHISLIERI COLLEGE

In the chapel's niches, statues of the Four Doctors of the Church (17th century). Piazza Collegio Ghislieri, 5 - open upon requeste

VISCONTEO CASTLE

The City Museums collection includes several paintings showing St Augustine. The Romanesque section displays various materials from the Basilica of S. Pietro in ciel d'oro. In the Chapel of the Assumption: a painting attributed to Bartolomeo Bonon (16") century). Corso Cairoli, 2 - opening times 7.00-11.30am | 3.30-7.00pm

ORATORY DEL SALVATORE (Part of the Episcopal Seminary complex) - on a

14 BASILICA OF S. MICHELE MAGGIORE
On the vault of the second bay, right nave, a fresco showing the Four Doctors of the Church, by Bernardino Lanzani (1508); on the right-hand side of the transept, the first the left, polyptych of Lombard school, entitled 'Madonna with the Child and Saints' (15th century). St Augustine is one of the saints in the group. Piazza S. Michele - opening times 8.30am-7.00pm

TE CHURCH OF S. SAN LUCA
On the niches along the nave, series with the Four Doctors of the Church (17th century).
Corso Giuseppe Garibaldi, 59 - opening times 7.30am-6.00pm

16 CHURCH OF S. CARLO BORROMEO

In the presbytery, a terracotta bas-relief showing St Augustine with St Monica, by G. Bonizzoni (1973). Via Montebolone, 1 - opening times 7.30am-7.30pm (in summer), 8.30am-6.00pm (in winter).
